Dear 8th Grade Parents,

The 2018-2019 8th Grade Promotion Ceremony will be at 5:00 pm on Thursday, May 23, 2019 at Plainfield South High School. We are well underway with plans for our ceremony, and we look forward to creating a memorable evening for students, staff, and families.

Promotion Practices During School:

May 22nd from 12:27-2:21-gown distribution

May 23rd from 7:55-9:51-ticket distribution

Promotion Tickets/Guests: We have limited seating in the main gym. Our class size allows us to provide 4 tickets per student for seating in the main gym—only guests with a ticket are seated in the main gym.

Additional seating is available in the auditorium, with a live video feed projected for everyone to see. The four tickets will be distributed to students during Promotion practice on May 23rd.

Promotion Ceremony Details:

It is very important that students are dropped off outside of the Fieldhouse at Plainfield South High School at 4:15 pm. All guests with a ticket should be seated in the Main Gym no later than 4:45 pm. The ceremony will start promptly at 5:00 pm.

No balloons, banners, or noise-makers will be allowed in the gymnasium. There will be several teachers and several Joliet Police Officers stationed at the gym doors to make sure such items do not enter into the gymnasium.

To ensure that all parents and guests are afforded the opportunity to hear their students' name announced, it is very important that guests do not cheer, yell, or applaud for their individual student. There will be an opportunity to applaud for all of the students once the names have all been called. Though we understand that some audience members may have good intentions, cheering, yelling, or applauding for individual students during the ceremony is disrespectful towards those families that would not be able to hear their student's name as a result. Our 8th grade students have worked too hard for their name not to be heard by the people that love them most.

Student attire guidelines: Students typically dress up for Promotion. Formal attire is not required; however, no jeans or gym shoes please.
